Dear Parents,

On **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2023**, Year 3 will be going on a visit to **Stump Cross Caverns**. We will be leaving school at **9:15am** so please ensure your child arrives at school no later than **8:45am**. The trip links to our current science topic and we will spend the day exploring the caves, finding out lots of exciting facts about rocks and fossils.

The cave temperatures are low which means that your child **must bring a warm coat** with them to keep warm while exploring. In some circumstances, large puddles can also be found in the cave, which means your child should **wear appropriate footwear**.

Your child will also need to bring a **packed lunch and water bottle** and this should be carried with them in a bag. Please complete the attached form by 2<sup>nd</sup> October to say if you are providing your child with a packed lunch or you would like a school packed lunch. The cost of the trip will be £11.75 which includes transport, entry into the caves and educational activities on the day. Although this is a voluntary contribution the school budget is not sufficient to cover the cost of the trip. If we do not receive sufficient donations, the trip may need to be cancelled and will not be able to go ahead. This payment can be made on ParentPay.

We will be leaving **Stump Cross Caverns** at **2:00pm** and expect to be back for the end of the school day.
